Anatomy & Physiology: Bones—Patella.

STRUCTURE.

- The kneecap bone.
- Small, triangular sesamoid.
- Base: the superior portion; widest portion of the triangle.
- Apex: the inferior "tip" of the triangle.
- Articular facets: posterior view; two facets (medial and lateral) allow for articulation with the femoral condyle.

FUNCTION.

CLINICAL SIGNIFICANCE.

• Increases the leverage of quadraceps femoris.
